## Course Rules and Dress Code

Mont Choisy Le Golf and Tamarina Golf & Spa both maintain a set of rules and policies regarding dress and behaviour which all participants in the International Golf Clinics programme are committed to follow.

These standards exist to ensure an exceptional experience for every golfer on the course. We are grateful for your cooperation and respect throughout the week.

## **Dress Code**

### **In the Clubhouse**

All persons entering the clubhouse must be appropriately dressed at all times. The following are not permitted in the clubhouse under any circumstances.

- Beachwear
- Vests
- Headwear worn indoors
- Sports shorts
- Flip-flops or sandals
- Golf shoes with metal spikes

### **On the Course**

Traditional golf attire is required on the course at all times. The following standards apply throughout your round.

- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Headwear must be worn with the peak facing forwards
- Short white socks are encouraged when wearing shorts
- Cargo shorts with side pockets are not permitted
- Denim is not permitted

## **Behaviour**

### **Respect for Staff and Fellow Golfers**

The teams at Mont Choisy Le Golf and Tamarina Golf & Spa work tirelessly to deliver an exceptional golfing experience. All participants are expected to treat every member of staff and every fellow golfer with respect at all times.

Anyone acting disrespectfully towards any team member or guest will be asked to leave the property.

### **Mobile Phones and Audio Devices**

Mobile phones and audio devices may be used on the course but must be used in a discreet and non-disturbing manner at all times. Please be considerate of other golfers and staff throughout your round.

## Golf Carts

- Carts must be kept on designated cart paths wherever possible
  - Carts must not be driven on or near tee and green complexes at any time
  - Only golfers over the age of 18 with a valid driving licence may operate a golf cart on the property

## Course Etiquette

### Pitch Marks and Divots

Please repair pitch marks on the greens and fill divots with the sand provided. If you are unable to repair your own please repair or fill those nearby. Small acts of care make a significant difference to the experience of every golfer on the course.

### Bunkers

Please rake bunkers carefully after every shot and leave the bunker in better condition than you found it.

### Pace of Play

Slow play is not tolerated on either course. Your position in the field is with the group ahead of you, not behind. The maximum allotted time for 18 holes is 4 hours 20 minutes.

Course marshals are present to ensure these standards are maintained for the enjoyment of all golfers. Please follow their instructions at all times.
